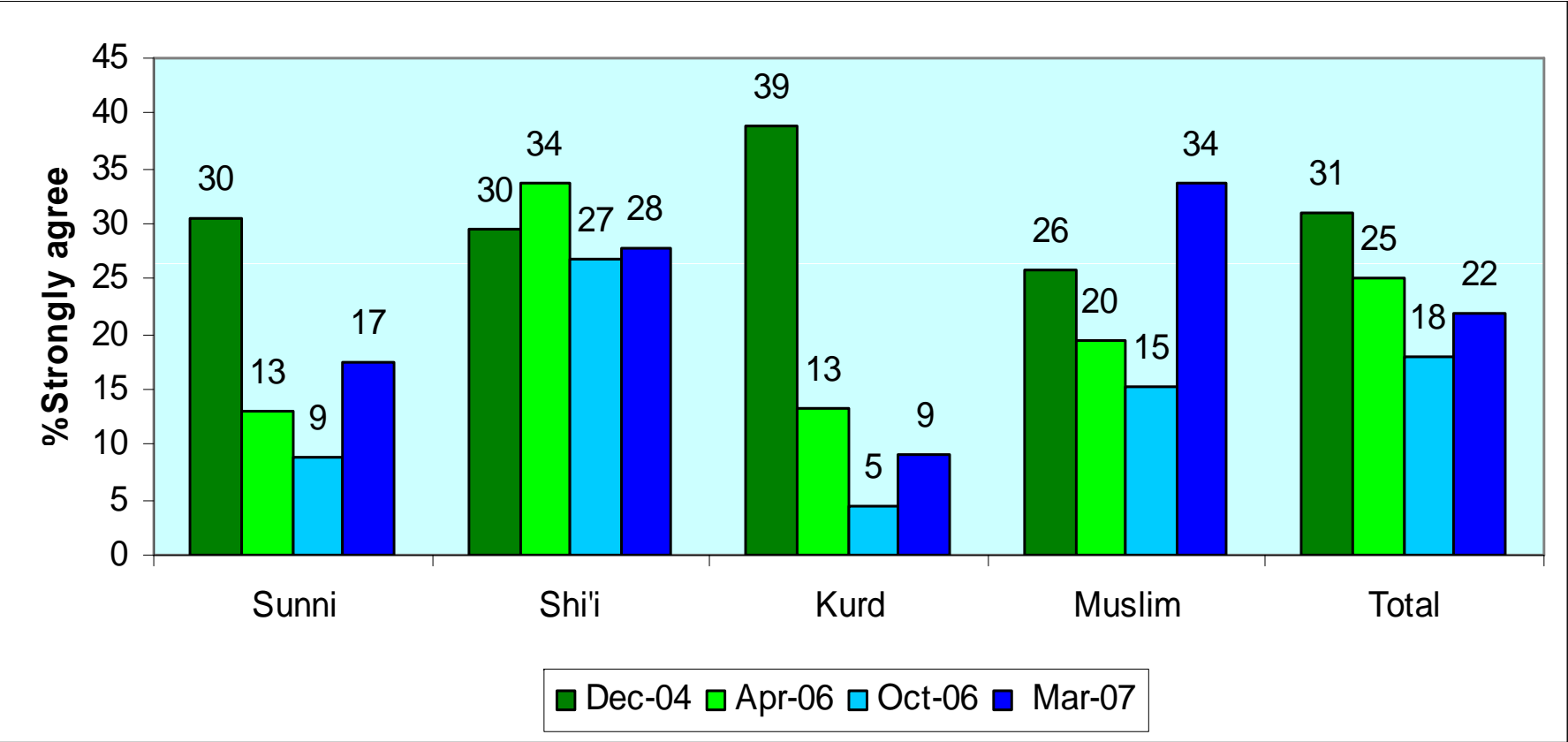

Increase in Support for Secular Politics

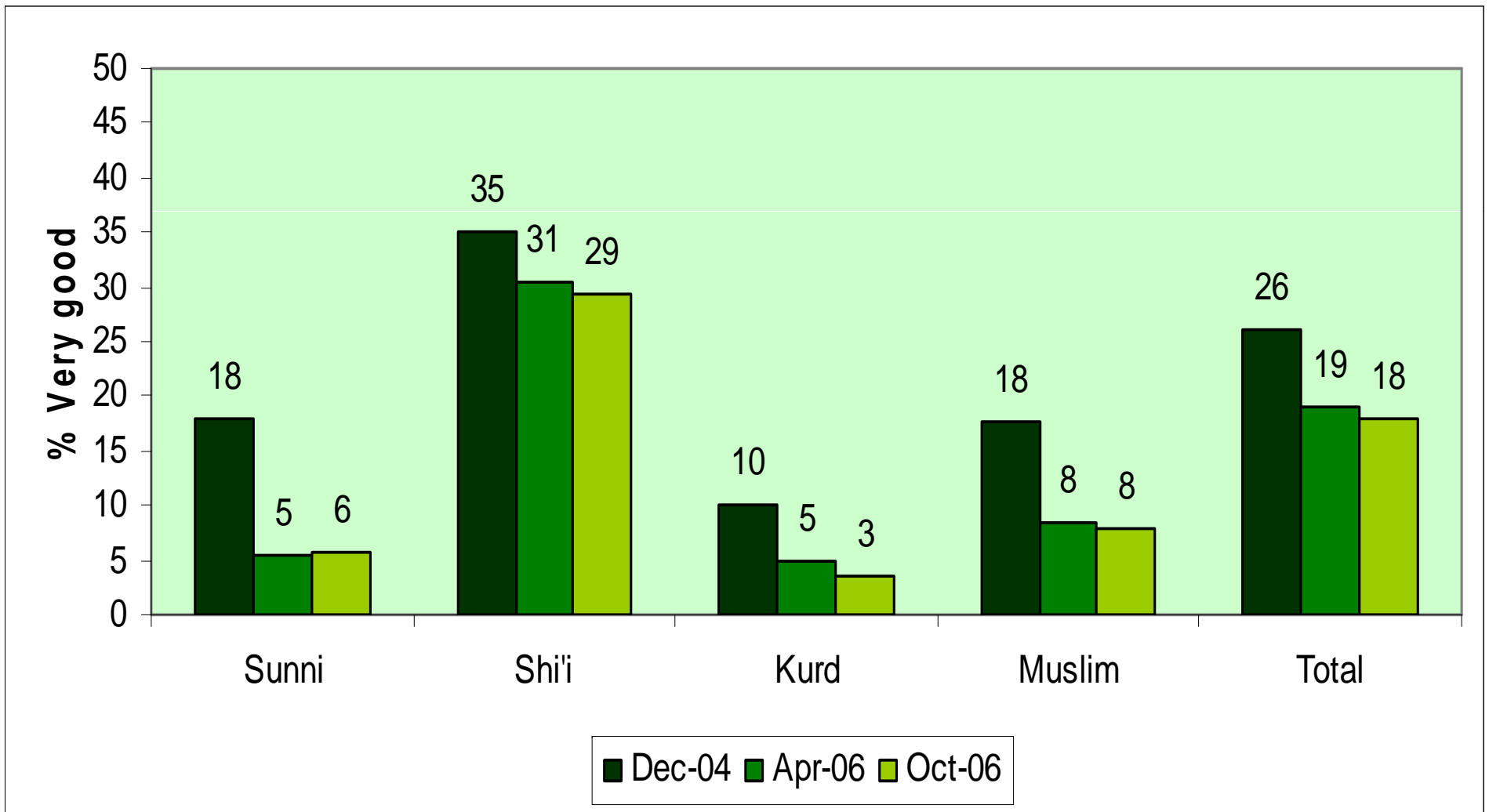
## Questions

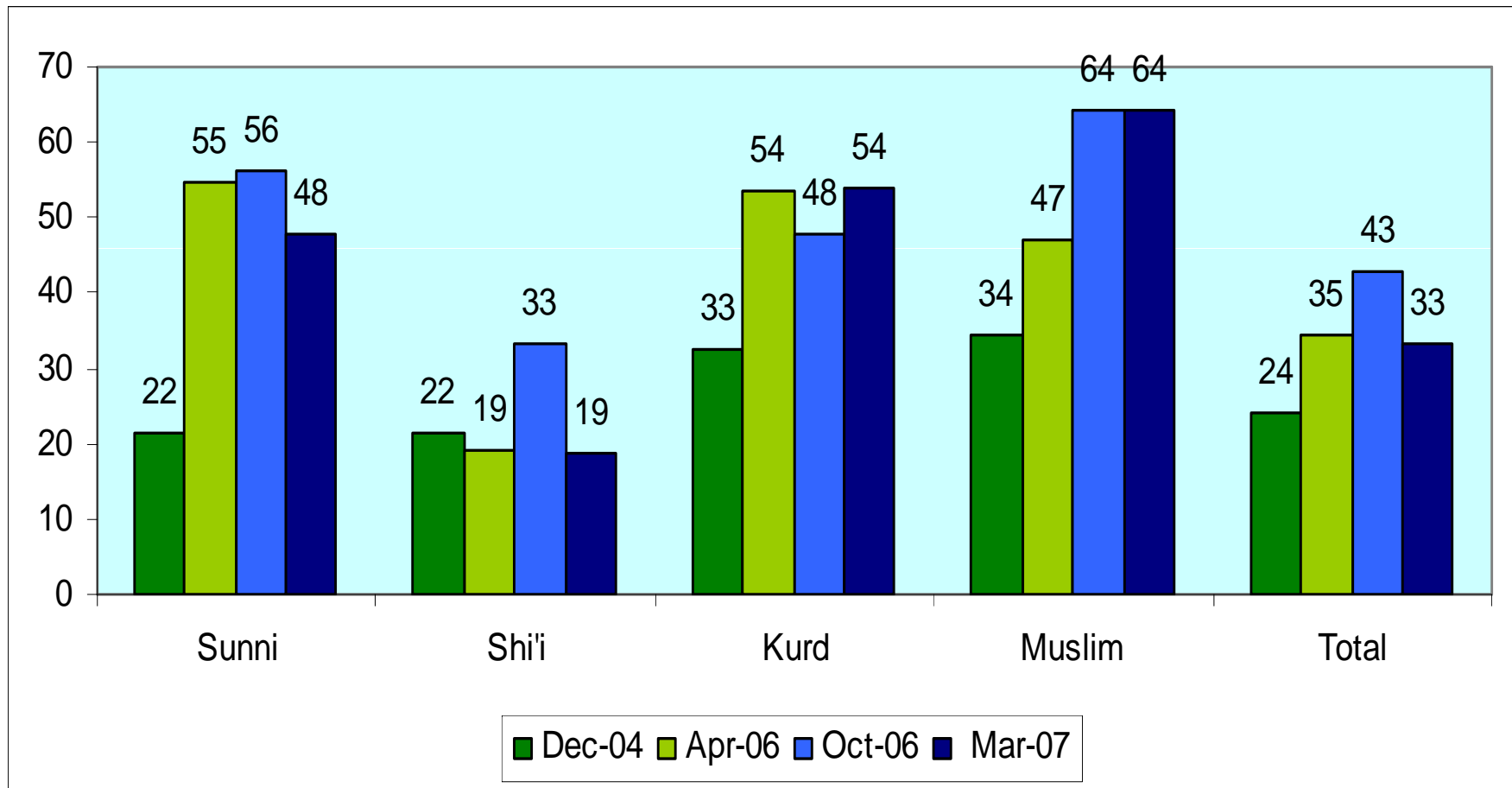
# % of Iraqis responding that having a government that implements only the laws of the Shari'a is 'Very Important'

# % of Iraqis 'strongly agreeing' that Iraq will be a better place if religion and politics are separated

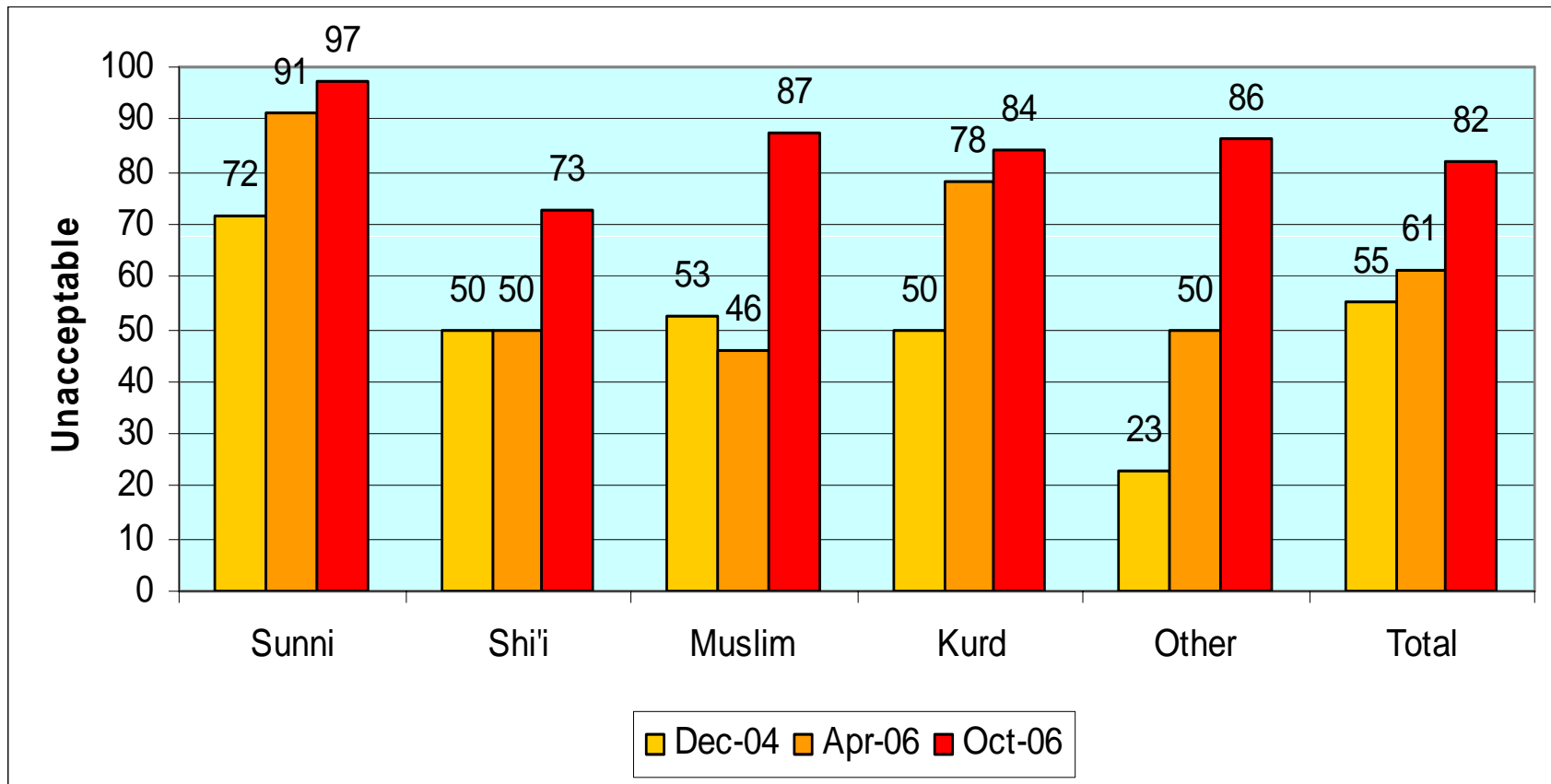


If these trends are true, then

- (b) There must be a decline in support for religious parties and an increase in support for secular parties in Iraq

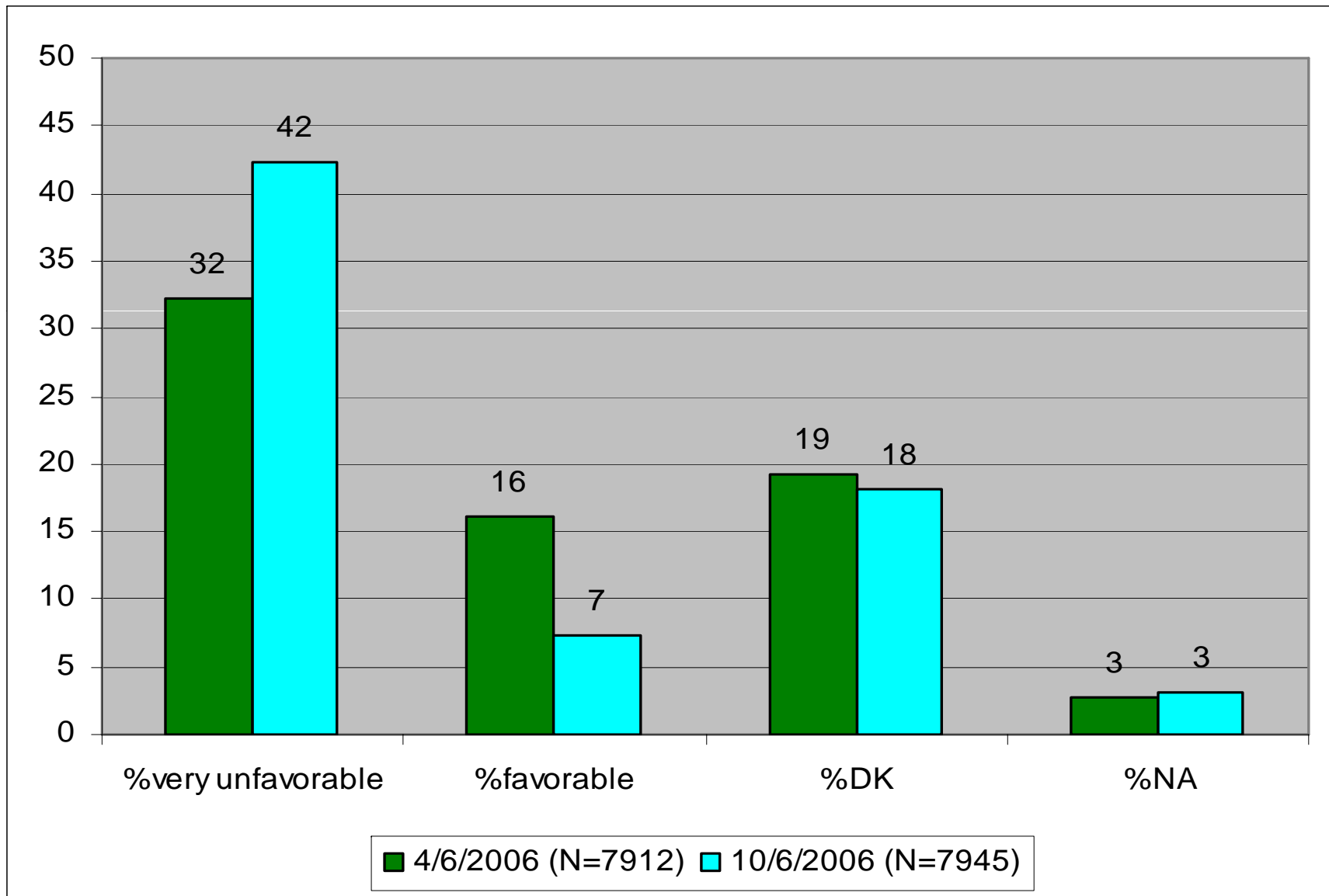


# % of Iraqis expressing that having Iranians as neighbors is unacceptable



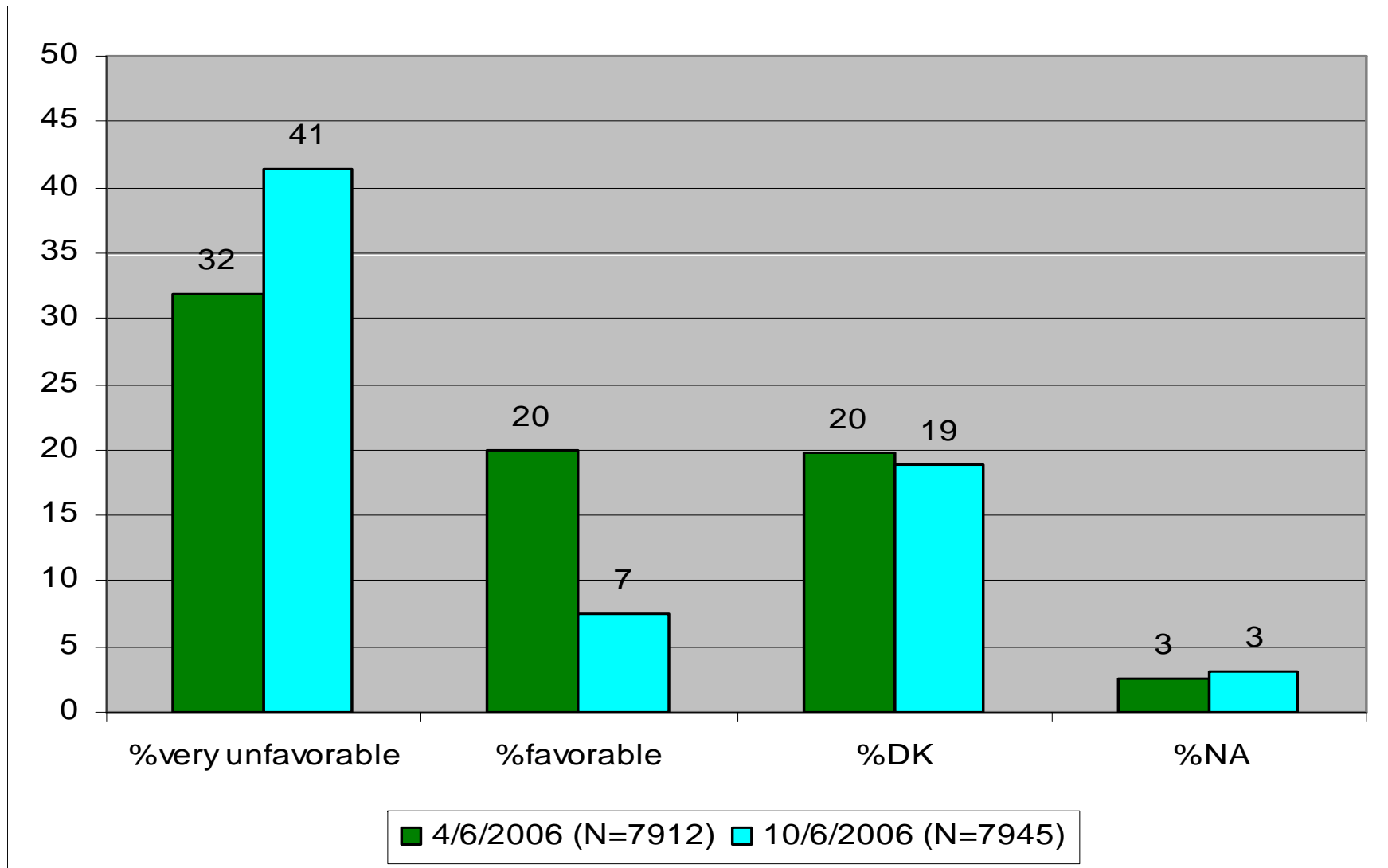

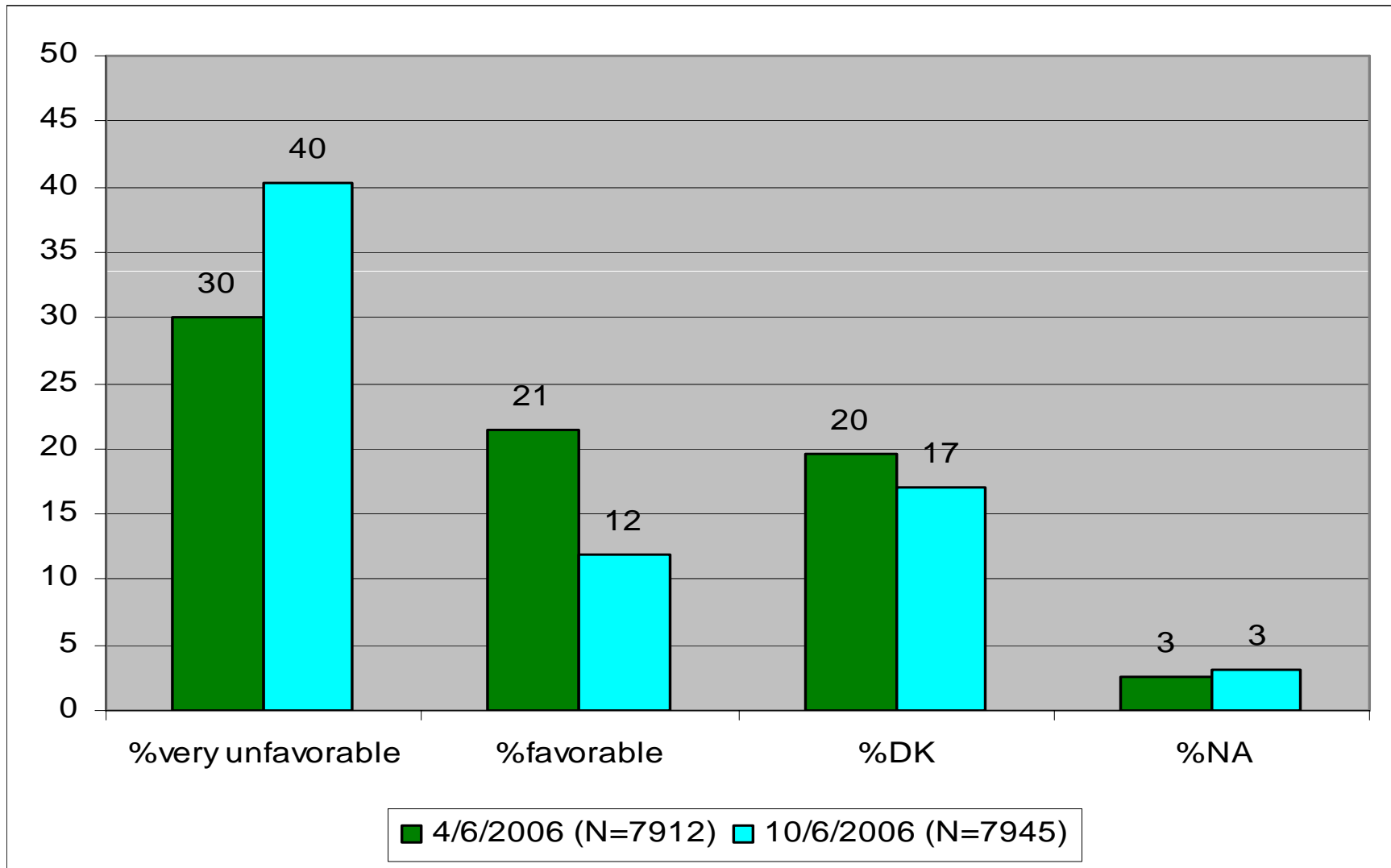

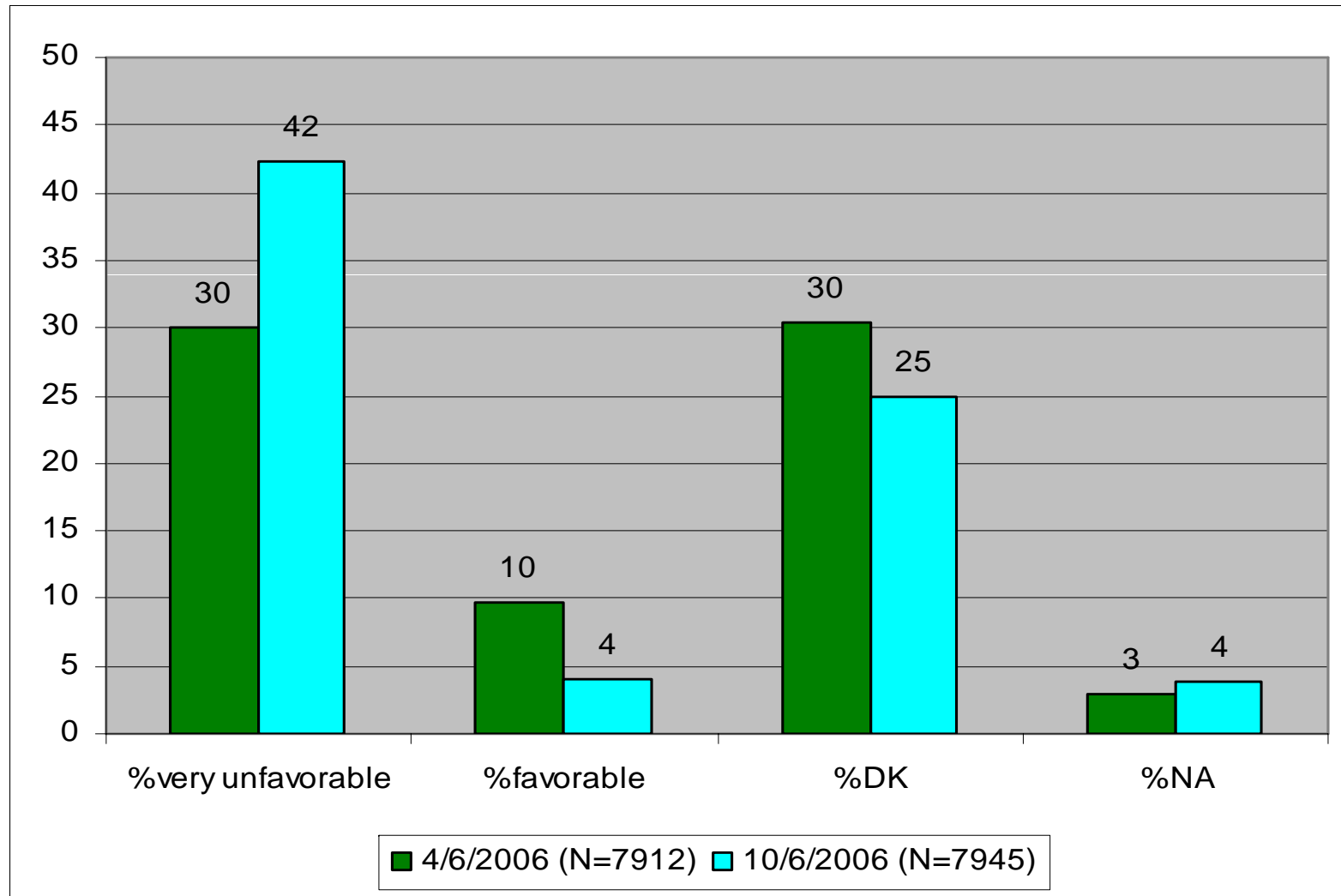

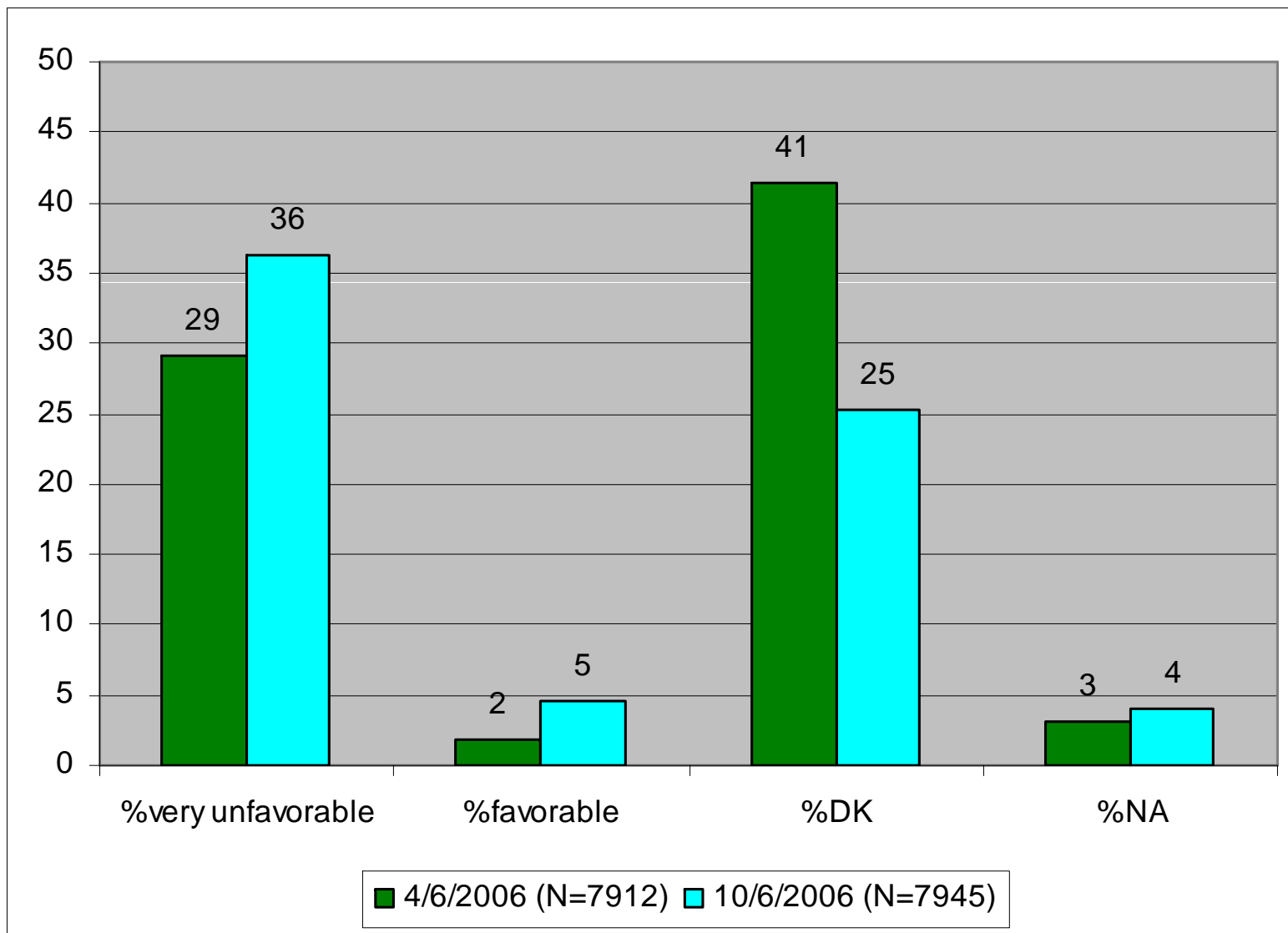

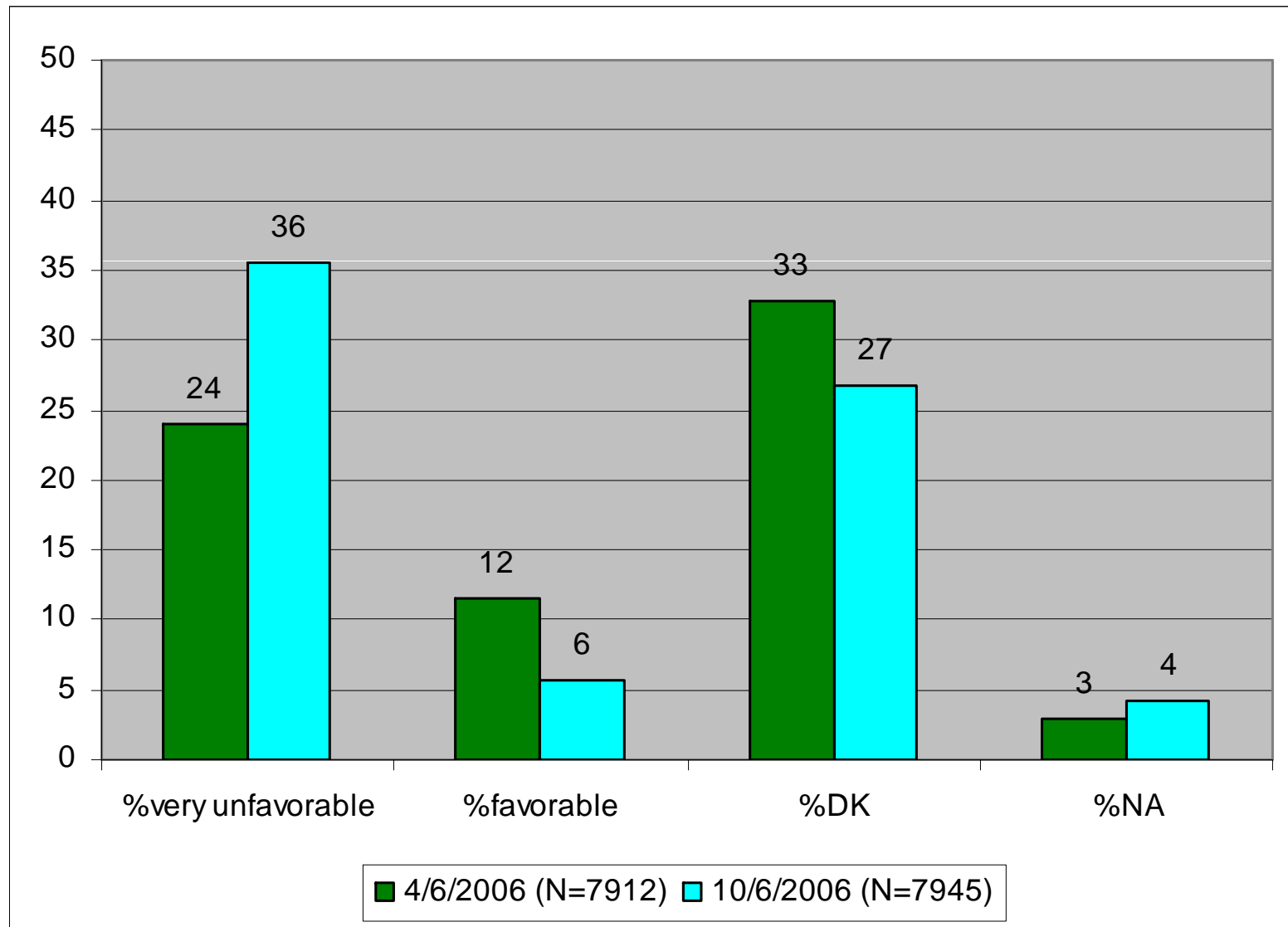

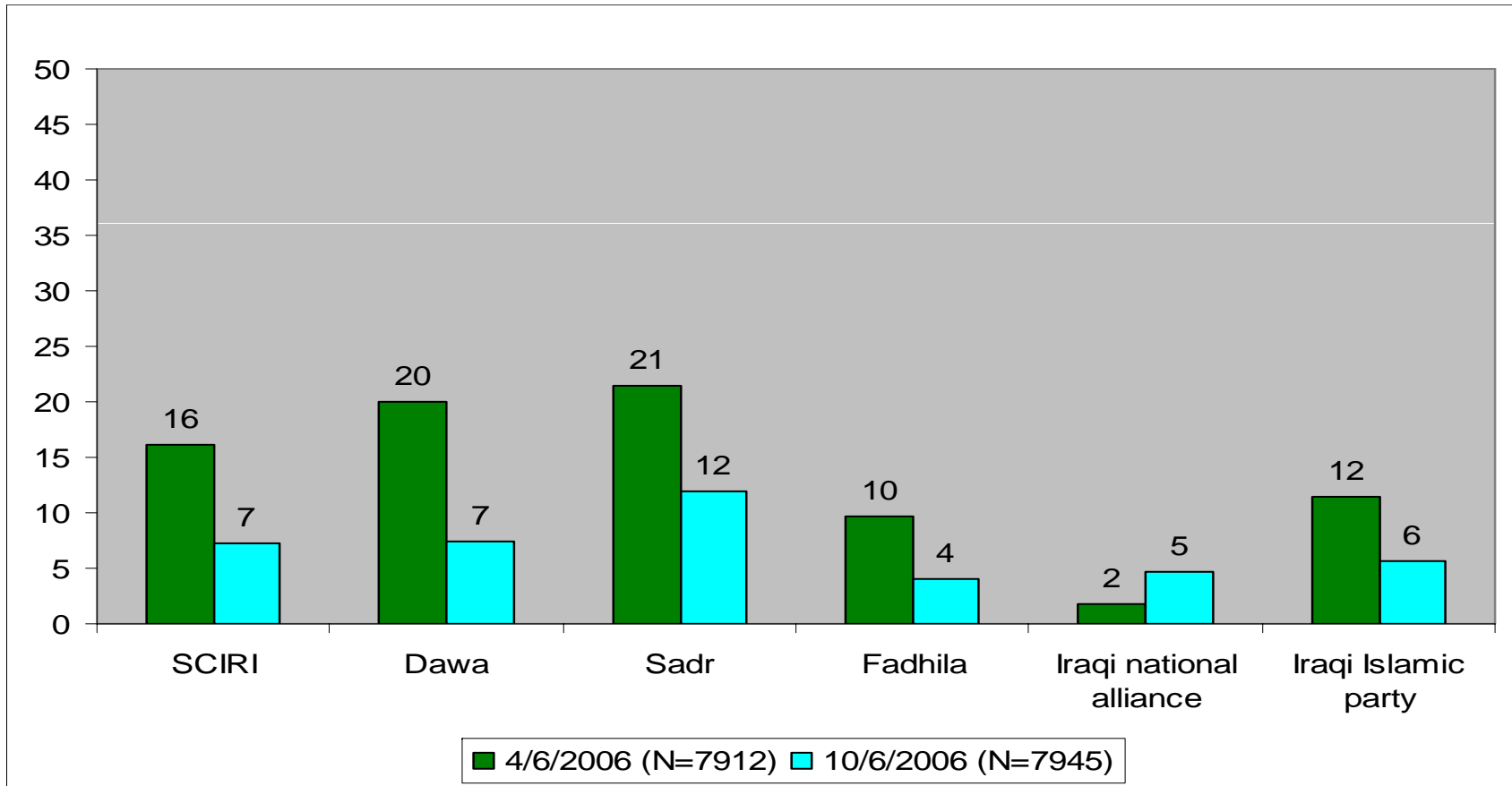

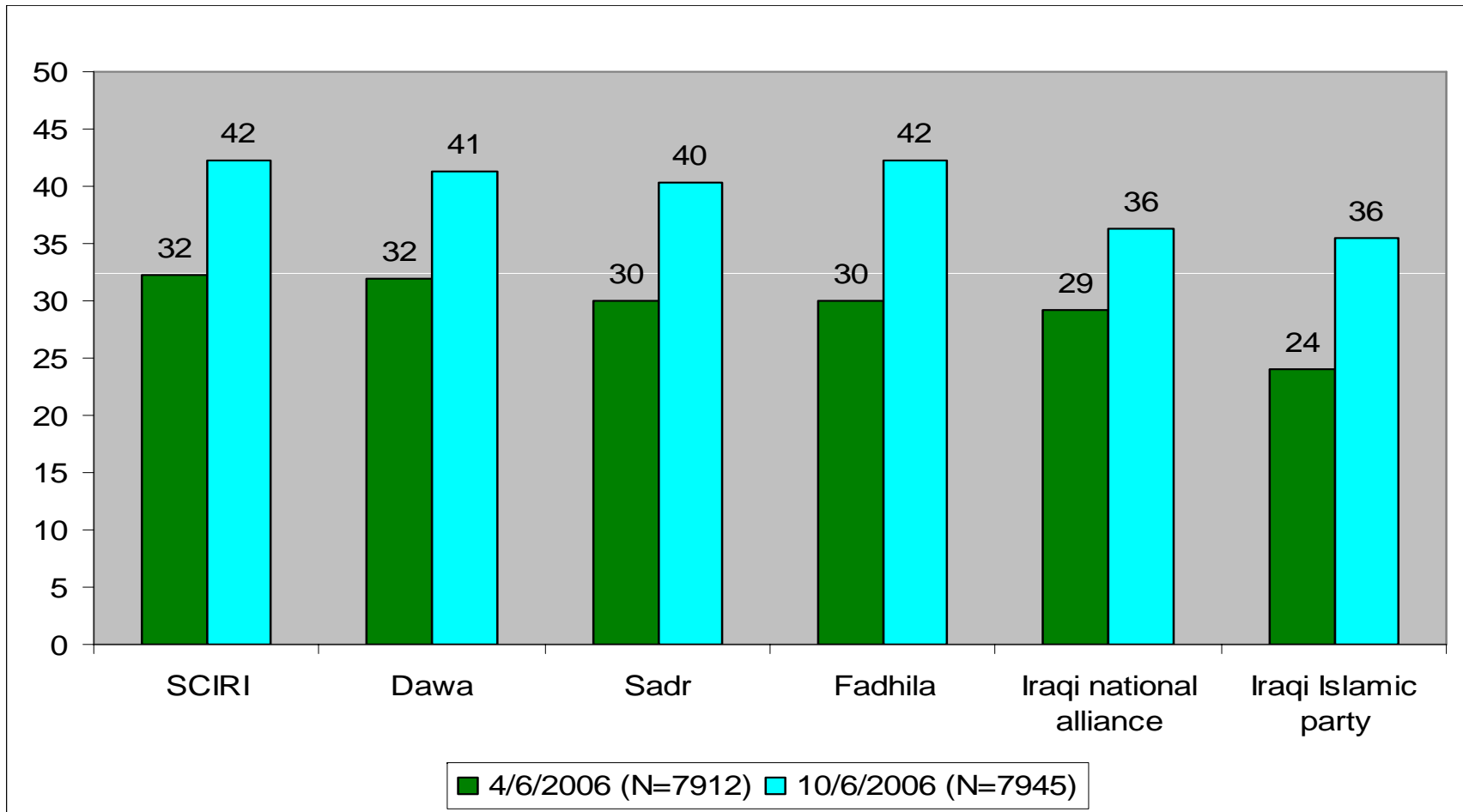

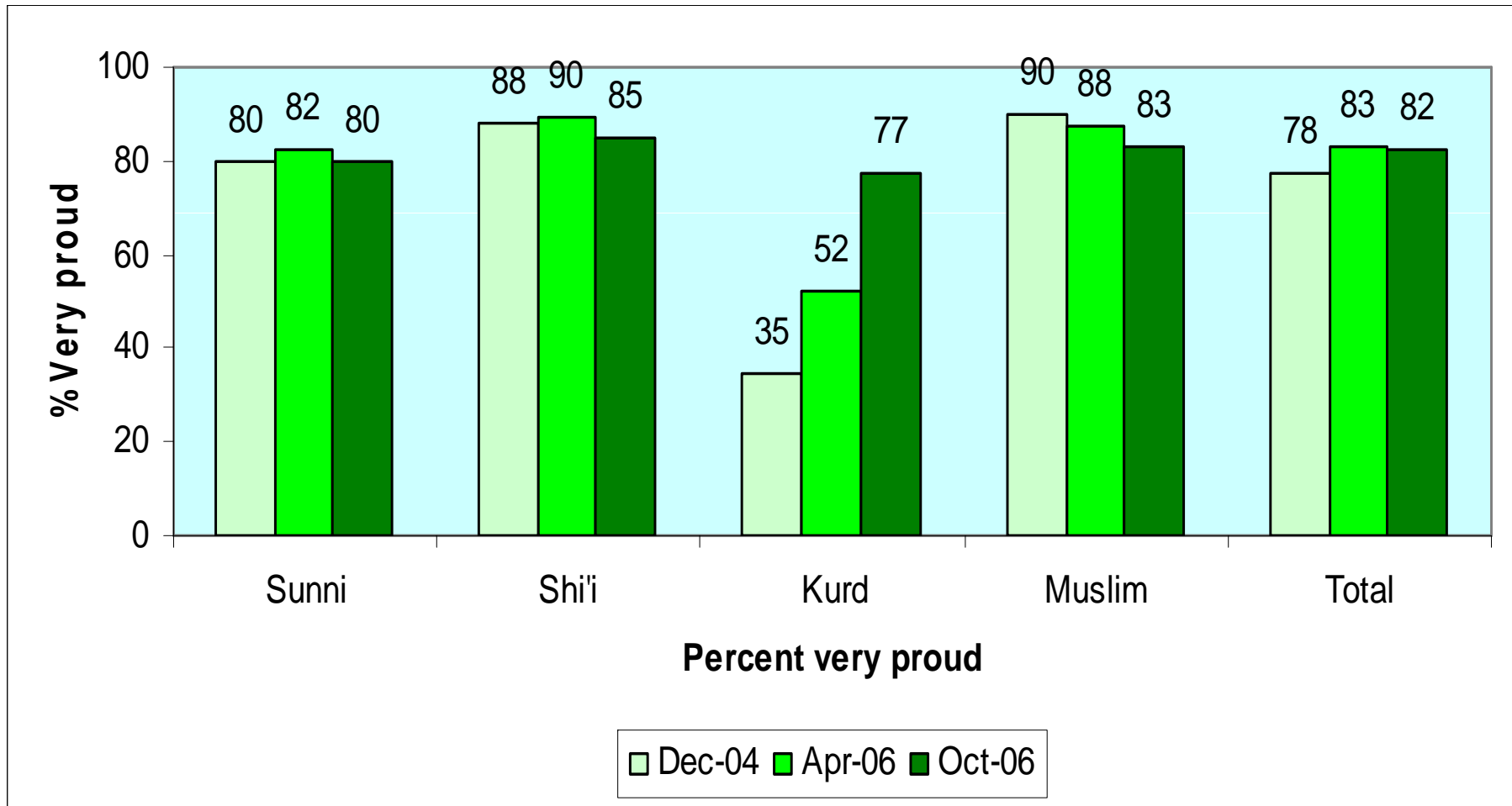

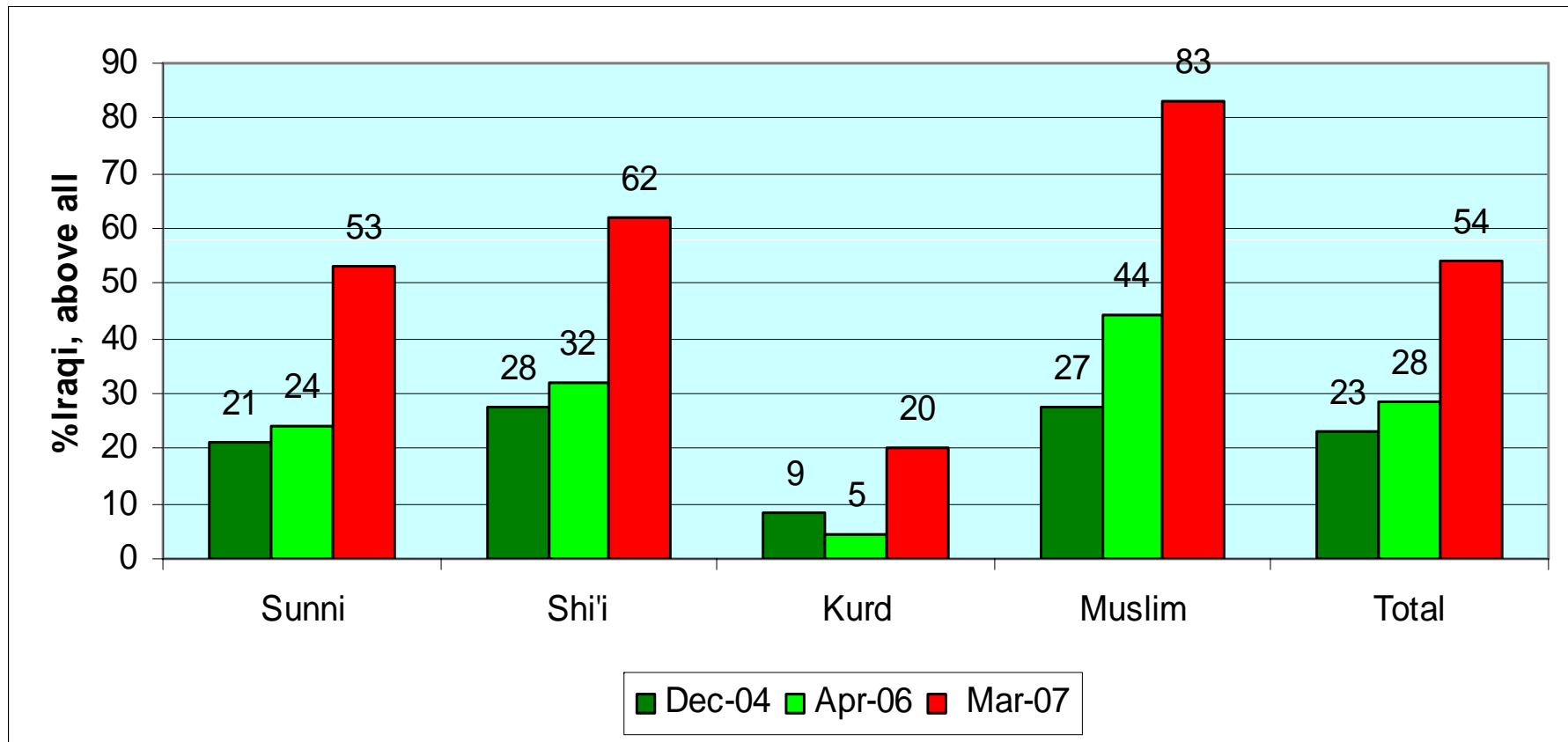

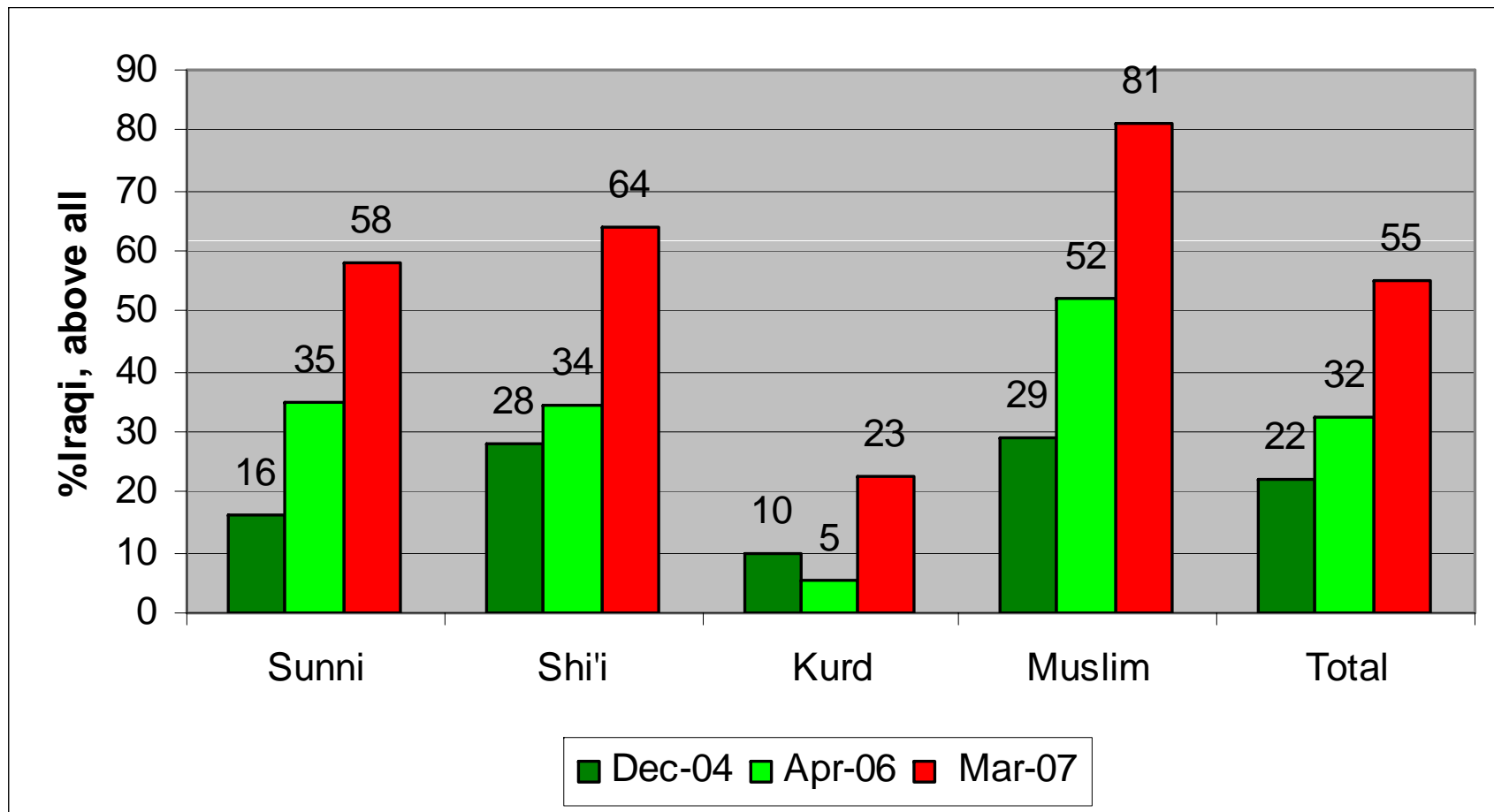

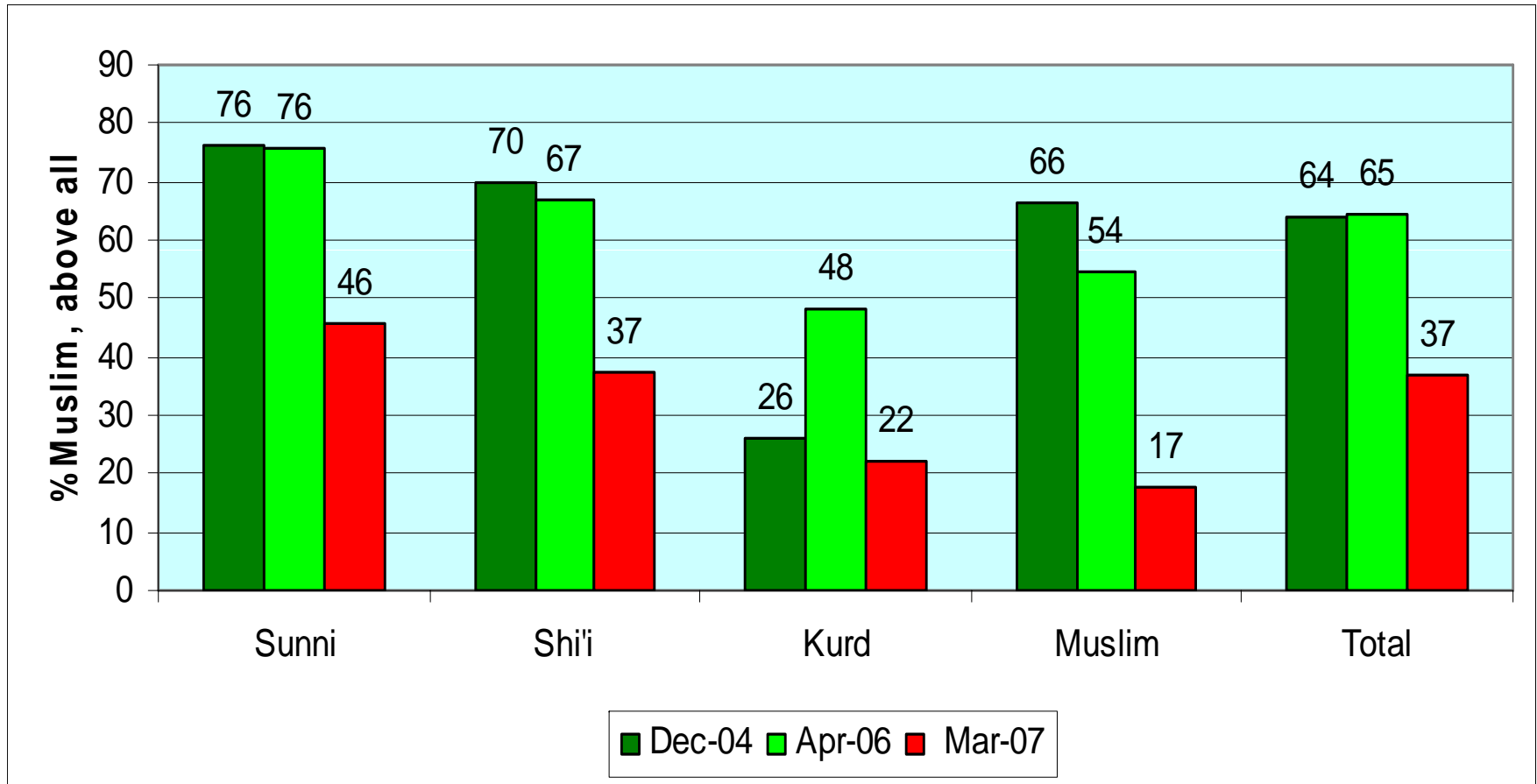
# %Iraqis describing selves as "Iraqis, above all"



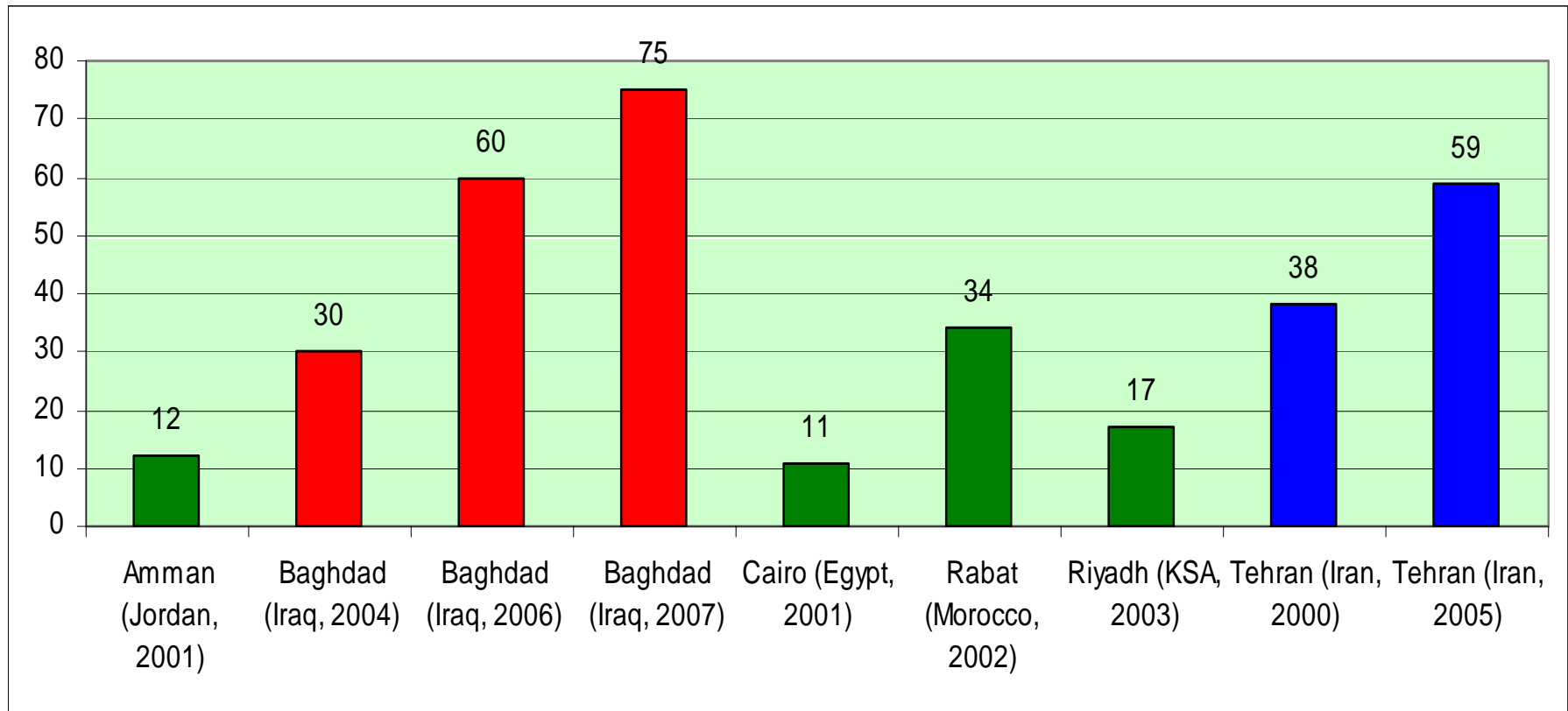
# %Iraqis describing selves as "Iraqis, above all" in urban areas



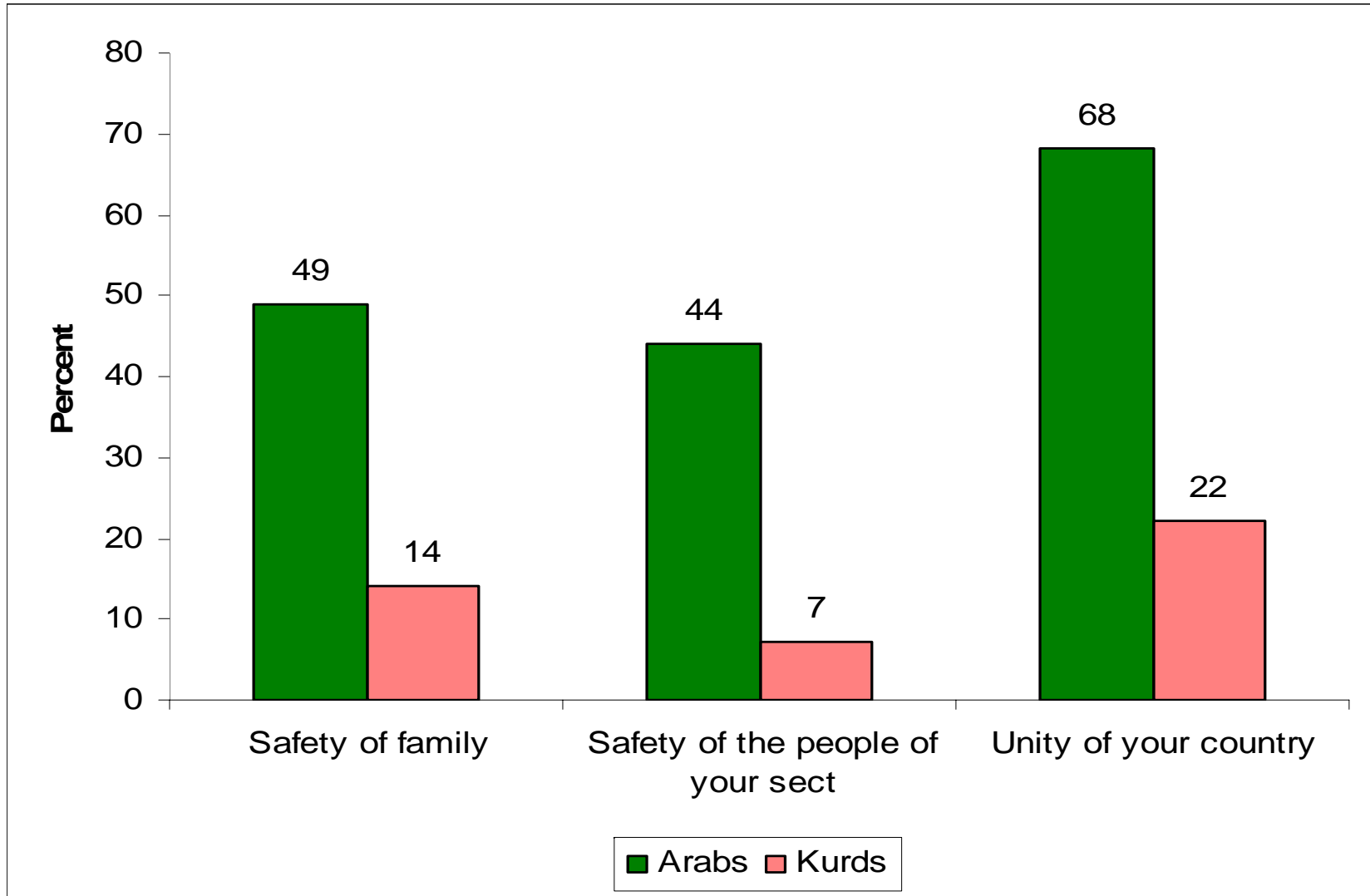
# %Iraqis describing selves as “Muslim, above all”



# %Describing self as “country nationalist, above all” in capital provinces/cities of major Middle Eastern countries

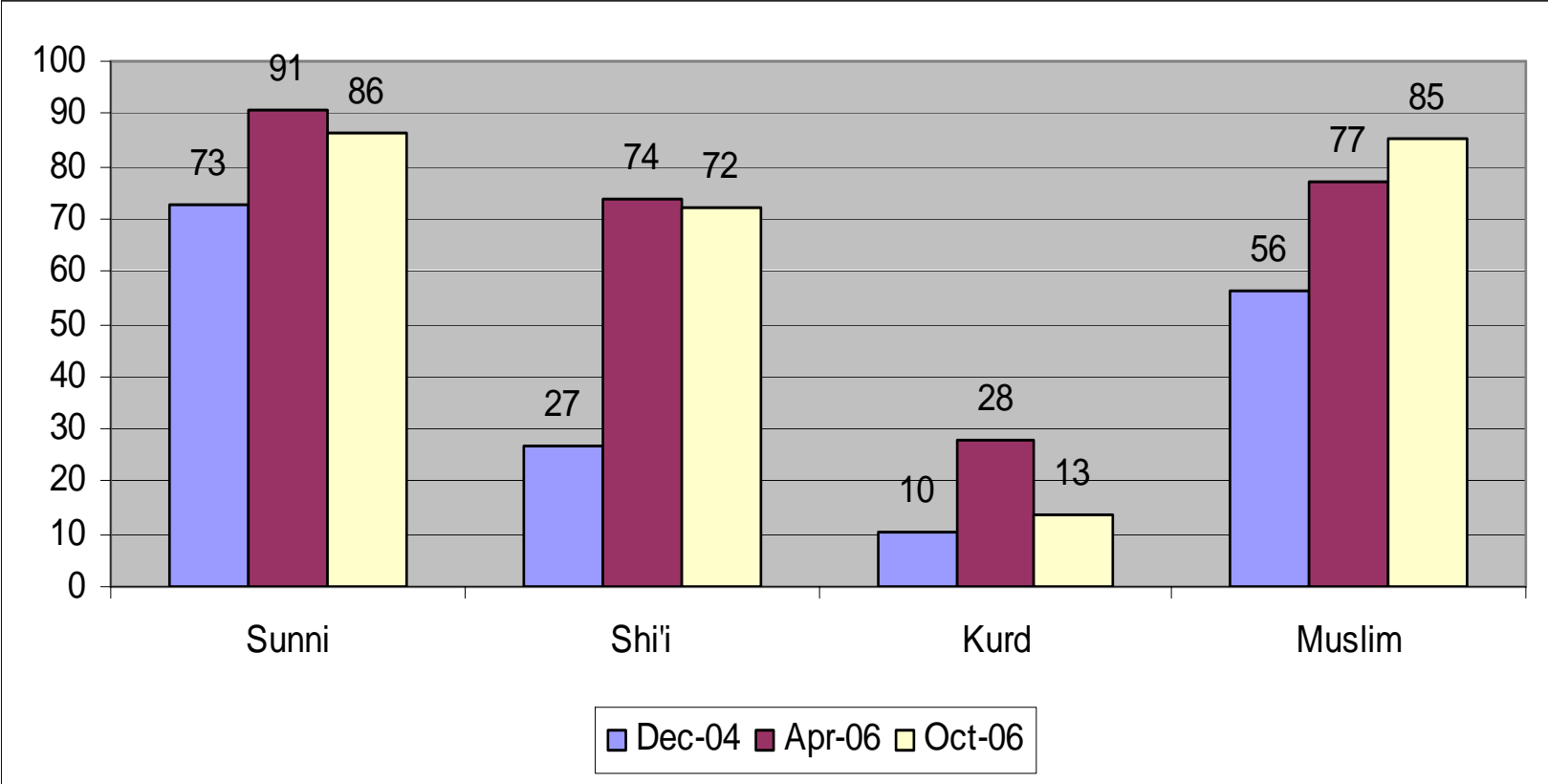


# %Expressing “very worried” about family, sect, and country among Arabs and Kurds

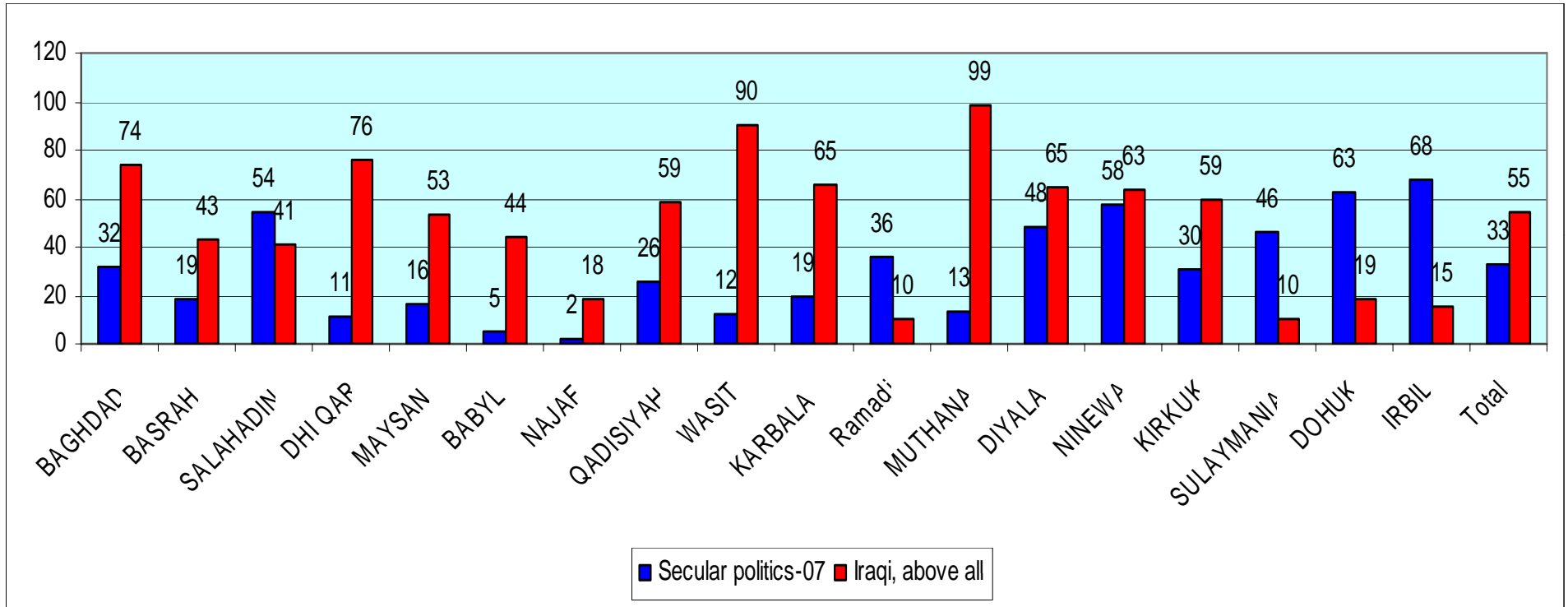




# When do you think U.S. and other Coalition Forces should leave Iraq? %Expressing "they should leave now"
